Enrollment: Preschool enrollment is on a first come, first served basis. The registration fee, curriculum fee and emergency kit fee are due at the time of enrollment. In order to accept your payment, all registration forms must be complete along with a copy of the birth certificate and immunization record. Parents have 30 days to submit a physician's report to the preschool office.

Payments Options: 1) Preschool payments can be paid in the Elementary School Office from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. Types of payments accepted are cash, check or money order. Cash must be the exact amount, as we DO NOT provide change. 2) Payments by check or money order ONLY, can be put in the Preschool Drop-Off Box located in the preschool hallway area above the check-in desk. 3) Preschool tuition and pizza can be paid online at gradelink.com.

Tuition: Preschool tuition is based on time and space reserved for your child; therefore, tuition credit will not be given for any absence due to illness, vacations, days the school is closed or early withdrawal. Monthly payments begin **September 9, 2020**, with consecutive payments due on the **19th** day of each month. If the account is not paid before the **26th** day of each month, a \$30 late fee will be charged to your account. Failure to submit tuition payment within 20 days of the due date may result in the school withdrawing your child from the school until payment is made.

Electronic Check In/Out:

An electronic check-in/check-out system is a required policy of Calvary Chapel Rialto Preschool. Upon enrollment, a custom code must be created by the child's parent/guardian, **for each emergency contact agent**. Parents/guardians must electronically check-in/check-out each child every morning and every afternoon. **Failure to comply may result in termination of enrollment.** It is the parent's responsibility to notify the preschool immediately whenever changes occur regarding emergency contact information. This will ensure the safety and protection of the children in our care.

Lunches:

Students must bring their lunch from home every day except Fridays. On Fridays, pizza will be brought in from an outside source and may be purchased for a nominal fee of **\$3.50 each Friday; this includes 2 slices of pizza, a juice box and a fruit snack. Weekly pizza fees will be applied to your account on the 5th of each month and may be paid along with your child's tuition.** Students are not required to purchase hot lunch and have the option of bringing their own lunch on Fridays.

For the health and safety of the children in our care, the following foods should NOT be packed in your child's lunch: hot dogs, grapes/cherries, popcorn, marshmallows or nuts.

Snacks:

Snacks are provided two times a day: once in the **morning** and once in the **afternoon**. Snacks will include 2 of the 4 food groups, and as provided by law, only 100% juice will be given to the children. Parents are welcome to donate unopened, healthy snacks to our snack kitchen.

Naps:

Nap time is from 12:00 pm to 2:15 pm, and is for children enrolled as full-time students. Nap time is important for developing preschool children and will allow them the energy needed to complete the day.

The preschool provides each child with a cot; however, the parent will need to provide a crib sheet and small blanket. These are to be sent to school in a duffel bag and be labeled with your child's name. **There will be a \$4 fee charged to your account each time a school sheet or blanket is used by your child.**
